Sub: Availability and accessibility of Electronic Resources to Allama Iqbal Library through E-ShodhSindhu Consortium (MoE), Govt. of India & Library Self-Subscriptions for the year 2021.

Allama Iqbal Library has been providing access to numerous resources in print and electronic format. Some of the electronic resources are centrally funded and are subscribed by INFLIBNET Centre under its **e-ShodhSindhu Consortium (eSS) for Higher Education E-Resources, Ministry of Education (MoE), Govt. of India** while as some are being subscribed by Allama Iqbal Library out of its allocated budget sub-head and on the basis of recommendations received from various departments/ centres/institutes/campuses of University of Kashmir and usage of the resources.

In this connection, we are pleased to inform you that the INFLIBNET Centre has renewed subscription to various e-resources subscribed under the e-ShodhSindhu Consortium for the year 2021. The consortium now offers differential access to more than **7,000 peer-reviewed electronic journals** from various publishers and database providers. The list is available under **E-Resources menu** and **Online Resources** tab of the library website.

Moreover, all the resources (centrally-funded & self-subscribed) can be accessed by all the registered/ bonafide library members including faculty members, research scholars and students not only within the University campuses but also from outside the campuses from anywhere and anytime by using state-of-the-art cloud hosted **Remote Access facility (RemoteXs Portal)** of Allama Iqbal Library. All the registered/ bonafide library members can register for Remote access facility at the link given at library website by clicking on **"Register (New User)"** and fill-up all the mandatory details for creation of their respective RemoteXS accounts. We are sure that faculty, research scholars and students of University of Kashmir will make optimum and effective use of these e-resources for their academic and research work.
